## BASKETBALL THROW



### RULES

- Athletes will compete in 5 (five) year age increments and gender.
- Athletes must register at the table upon arriving at the competition and choose play format.
- Medals will be awarded in both formats by age groups.
- A referee will score at each goal.
- Format A-standard 15 shots from designated free throw line.
  - Age 50-69, male/female will begin the game by shooting from the free throw line, 15 feet from the foul line on a rim height of 10 feet.
  - Ages 70-79, males, will begin the game by shooting from a 12-foot line on a rim height of 10 ft.
  - Ages 70-79, women, will begin the game by shooting from a 10-foot line on a rim height of 8ft.
  - Ages 80 and up men/women/seated/assisted will begin the game by shooting from an 8-foot line at a rim height of 8 feet.
  - Scoring 1 point per shot made.
- Format B-Round the key shots-3 times from 5 positions
  - Athletes will move around the zone to their left and shoot at each mark on the zone-5 marks per side or a total of 15 shots.
  - Scoring-1 point per shot made.
  - Players must remain behind designated line when shooting, otherwise shot will not count.
- Decision of the referee and event manager is final.

- Medals are awarded at the end of the competition.
