SHUFFLEBOARD



Rules



- **Object of game.** Shuffle the disks into the scoring areas without the disks touching any white lines with the **exception** of the white line that divides the 10 off box; that does not count for scoring only to divide the play area.
- **Knocking out an opponents disk is encouraged.**
- **Rules of play.** Players begin at designated court location. Yellow on right and black on the left of court. 2 players per end of court in same age group or with same mobility issues.
- **Direction of play.** Yellow disk player shuffles 1 disk from right side of court, black disk player shuffles 1 disk from left side of court and can knock out the yellow disk or aim for points. Play continues alternating disks and scores are recorded once all disks are played.
- **Players will play 7 frames for a total score.** Total score is entered per athlete per age group based on male or female to determine winners.

- **Format.** 2 players will be assigned to each end of the court. Players may compete with a variety of age groups. Medals will be awarded per age/gender group. **Decision of the scorekeeper is final.**
- **General Court rules.** Players cannot interfere with other players and must remain seated when they are not shuffling.
- **Scoring.** Number of points per frame per individual will be recorded based on location of the disks after the 4 disks are shuffled. Person with the highest score per age group/gender win the designated medals.
- **In the event of a tie, dual medals will be awarded.**
- **Medals will be awarded at the end of the tournament.**
- **Decision of the event manager is final.**
