Highlights of New Events and Adjusted Rules

PLEASE BE AWARE DAYTIME EVENTS MAY GO PAST 12 NOON AND MEDALS ARE AWARDED AT THE END OF THE EVENT.

Dominoes-new event.

- One gold, silver and bronze medal are awarded based on points scored in 3 rounds of play.
- Each round may consist of more than 1 game as the winner must earn 100 points per round to move to the next table.
- In the event of a tie dual medals will be awarded.

GIVEAWAY Checkers-new event

- One gold, silver and bronze medal awarded based on 3 game format win/loss record. Medals will not be awarded by age group or M/F and in the event of a tie dual medals will be awarded.
- The object of the game is to get rid of all your pieces first (or be blocked). You do this by forcing your opponent into capture. If a player can capture, he/she must do so.
- Gameplay is otherwise the same as Standard Checker Rules.

BASKETBALL Throw

- Standard 15 shot format per age group from designated free throw line.
- Medals awarded per 5-year age groups, M/F.
- Game is adaptable based on the athlete's ability to participate.

BOCCEBALL

- Standard bocce rules. Based on 4 tosses per round of play.
- Players may play more than one round to ensure age groups are matched appropriately. The first-round score count will be recorded.
- Game will be adaptable based on the athlete's ability to participate.
- Scored in 5-year age groups, M/F.

SHUFFLEBOARD

- Standard shuffleboard rules. Based on 6 shuffles per game, 2 games per round.
- Players may play more than one round to ensure age groups are matched appropriately. The first-round score will be recorded.

PICKLEBALL

- Standard rules apply.
- PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THE TIME OF YOUR AGE GROUP COMPETITION.
- Players will draw for position in the bracket. If you are late, you may not be able to play.
