Rules

DIVISIONS

- Singles
- Doubles (compete in lowest age group)
- Mixed Doubles (compete in lowest age group)
- No-Tap Singles

• RULES

- Competition will consist of 3 games, and each game will consist of 10 frames for each competitor.
- No handicap will be awarded.
- Late participants cannot start bowling after completion of 3rd frame.
- Each player bowls two balls in each frame unless a strike is made on the first ball, then the second ball is not rolled except in the tenth frame.
- No-tap strike rules. 8 or 9 pins down on first ball for all women and men over 90 counts as a strike. 9 pins down on first ball for men 89 and under counts as a strike. Second ball is rolled only if strike not rolled with first ball.

SCORING

- The highest score will be determined for each competitor by totaling score from all three games.
- Medals will be awarded at the end of play. Duplicate medals will be awarded in case of a tie.
